BY-LAW 23-2005

A BY-LAW OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF CARLETON PLACE TO REGULATE SNOW CLEARING AND REMOVAL OPERATIONS WITHIN THE SAID MUNICIPALITY

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of Section 130 of *The Municipal Act*, S.O. 2001, the Council of every municipality has the authority to regulate the matters for the health, safety and well-being of the inhabitants of the municipality;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Carleton Place enacts as follows:

SECTION 1 - REGULATIONS

- No person (including the owner or occupant) of any class of building may clear or remove ice or snow from buildings, sidewalks, driveways or parking lots and place this snow onto the property of another owner or occupant without first obtaining their consent.
- No person (including the owner or occupant) of any class of building may clear or remove ice or snow onto a municipal road allowance or other municipal property without first obtaining the municipality's consent.
- 3. Snow or ice placed on a municipal road allowance or on other municipal property shall be removed by municipal forces or their agents, and the cost of removing this ice or snow shall be charged to the owner of the property from where the ice or snow originated.

SECTION II - ENFORCEMENT

- Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this by-law and the
 procedures with respect thereto of an offence, and the enforcement and the
 penalty imposed thereunder shall be subject to the provisions of *The Provincial*Offences Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter P.53 and any amendments thereto, and the
 penalty for the commission of any such offences shall be provided for in the said
 Provincial Offences Act.
- 2. This by-law shall be enforced by the Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer and/or by an Officer of the Carleton Place Detachment of the Ontario Provincial Police.

SECTION III - SHORT TITLE

1. This By-law may be referred to as The Snow Clearing and Removal By-law.

SECTION IV - REPEAL OF BY-LAW

1. That By-law No. 64-97 and amendments thereto be hereby repealed.
