

BY-LAW NO. 61-2008

**A BY-LAW OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF CARLETON PLACE TO
CONFIRM THE DEEMING OF ONE THIRD OF THE REMUNERATION PAID TO
ELECTED MEMBERS OF COUNCIL AS EXPENSES INCIDENTAL TO THE
DISCHARGE OF THEIR DUTIES**


WHEREAS Section 283 (7) of the Municipal Act, 2001 states that on or after December 1, 2003 a council shall review a by-law under sub-section (5) at a public meeting at least once during the four year period corresponding to the term of office of its members after a regular election.

AND WHEREAS in accordance with Section 5 of Section 283 the municipality adopted a resolution to deem one-third of the Council remuneration as tax free.


NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Carleton Place enacts as follows:

1. That in accordance with Section 283(5) and (7) of the Municipal Act, 2001, that Council confirms the one third tax exemption of the remuneration paid to Council.
