Skate Park & Pump Track

Carleton Place has a Biking Pump Track, as well as a seasonal skate park. The Bike Pump Track is located in between the Carleton Place Arena and the Carleton Place Curling Club. It can be accessed via the Carleton Place Curling Club Parking Lot, the Mississippi Riverwalk Trail, and the Begley Street Park.

Carleton Place also now has a temporary skate park located in the Arena Parking Lot between the months of May and October. The skate park will remain at this location until a permanent location is established.
