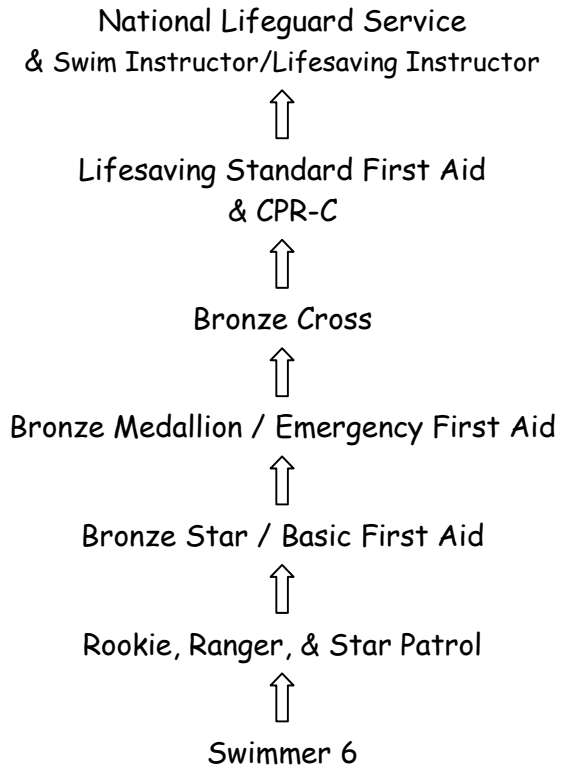

Aquatic Program Policies

- **Prior to the start date of a program** - Full refunds may be requested, less administration fees. The administration fee will be waived if the account is credited. Administrative fees apply if a refund cheque is requested.
- Account credits cannot be transferred to a refund request at a later date and can only be used for future program registrations
- **No refunds, credits, withdrawals, or transfers will be permitted from the program on the start date or later, this applies to private lessons as well.**
- Pro-rated refunds, less administration fees, will be considered after the start date for medical reasons ONLY supported with documentation.
- Pricing may change without notice. Prices are tax included unless otherwise stated.
- Aquatic staff reserves the right to transfer individuals to improve class ratios and customer service. Aquatic staff may cancel or change programs due to low enrollment or scheduling conflicts.
- **No refunds or credits will be permitted should a lesson or private lesson is missed due to unforeseen circumstances such as a pool fouling, or pool closure in inclement weather.**
- Waitlists will be permitted ONLY if ALL classes are full. Waitlists are not used to accommodate special time requests.
