

Carleton Place Celebrates Canada's 150th Thursday June 29th, 2017. Start Time- 6:30pm Community Celebration Parade Registration Information

We thank you for your interest in joining us for the 2017 Carleton Place Community Celebration Parade! Please review the rules and regulations listed below. By signing the registration form, it has been declared that you have read and understand the rules and regulations.

Participants Rules/Regulations

- 1. The parade begins at Townline Rd, travels down Bridge Street, turning left at Lake Avenue and ending at the Market Square Pavilion. Floats will be assembled in the staging area (on Bridge Street in front of the Carambeck Community Centre/Pool) on a first come, first serve basis. Floats are asked to disperse at the Market Square Pavilion, and float parking is welcome at the Carleton Place Arena- 75 Neelin St.
- 2. Completed Entry Forms and Permission Forms must be received by June 9, 2017.
- 3. All entries must be based upon a Canada Day theme and entertaining to a family audience.
- 4. All equestrian and live animal entrants must provide their own easily identifiable clean-up crew.
- 5. Parade Entries with any type of vehicle MUST provide copy of the vehicle insurance.
- 6. Each Mascot walking in the Parade MUST have at least one handler and walk on the sidelines of the Parade, to ensure safety.
- 7. Floats carrying passengers are required to be constructed with safety railings around the perimeter of the trailer OR all passengers are to remain seated while the vehicle is in motion.
- 8. Parade entries must remain in a forward motion. No stopping to perform during Parade. Please ensure your entry keeps pace with the parade to avoid large gaps.
- 9. Any entrant considered to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be removed from the parade and celebration. Participants in the parade shall not be consuming or giving the impression of consuming alcoholic beverages and shall refrain from smoking during their participation in the parade.
- 10. Do not throw candy or other items from moving vehicles; items may be distributed from the street level. The use of water guns or sprayers are not permitted, and such items will be confiscated.
- 11. Participants must ride on the inside of the float. Do not ride on the edge of the float trailer with feet dangling over the sides. Children should be securely seated and supervised at all times.
- 12. Entries that do not meet Parade Rules or differ from its approved entry form may be refused Parade or Celebration entry.
- 13. All entries must be lined up in the staging area no later than 6:00pm in preparation for the 6:30pm start.
- 14. Pre-registration is mandatory. All Entries will be notified in June of their Participation Status.
