

Docks and Public Boat Launches



A public boat launch is available at the West end of Lake Avenue. 2017 Fees are as follows (Prices are subject to change in 2018):

Single day: \$8.00

Season pass (resident of Carleton Place):\$46.50

Season pass (non-resident): \$85.00

Season passes can be purchased at the Town Hall between 9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. Monday - Friday. Single day passes can be purchased at the boat launch.

Public Dock

The Town has docking at Riverside Park, near the Lake Avenue West boat launch. There is also two municipal docks located off the public parking area across from the Town Hall on Bridge Street. There is also a small dock at Centennial Park for recreational canoe/kayak usage.
