NOTICE OF PASSING OF AN AMENDMENT TO SCHEDULE "A" OF DEVELOPMENT PERMIT BY-LAW 50-2008 TOWN OF CARLETON PLACE – DPA-02-2013

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Town of Carleton Place passed By-law No. 06-2014 on the 28th day of January 2014, under Section 34 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O., 1990. The application effects lands described as Block 107, Plan 27R-41 in the Town of

Carleton Place.

The purpose and effect of the amendment is to designate the subject lands from Community Commercial (CC) to Residential (R). The applicant is proposing to construct three residential apartment dwellings with a total of 48 units and associated parking and landscape/amenity space. The Development Permit Amendment application (DPA-02-2013) has been made for the subject lands that will reflect the concurrent Official Plan Amendment (OPA 10). A Class 3 Development Permit Application (DP3-07-2013) has also been submitted concurrently which provides the site layout details associated with the development.

TAKE NOTICE that any person or public body may appeal to the Ontario Municipal Board in respect of the by-law by filing with the Clerk of the Town of Carleton Place, **not later than the February 26, 2014**, a notice of appeal setting out the reason for the appeal. An appeal must be accompanied by the fee required by the Ontario Municipal Board.

Only individuals, corporations and public bodies may appeal a by-law to the Ontario Municipal Board. A notice of appeal may not be filed by an unincorporated association or group. However, a notice of appeal may be filed in the name of an individual who is a member of the association or group on its behalf. No person or public body shall be added as a party to the hearing of the appeal unless, before the by-law was passed, the person or public body made oral submissions at a public meeting or written submissions to the council or, in the opinion of the Ontario Municipal Board, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.
