**LAWN WATERING BY-LAW 19-2000**

It is important for residents to follow the Lawn Watering By-Law to ensure that water shortages do not occur. The Town of Carleton Place has restrictions when residents can water their lawns. This By-Law regulates the consumption and use of water from the first day of May to the last day of September, the following regulations apply:

1. No person using the Town of Carleton Place water supply system shall water from more than one connection.
2. Residents occupying an even-numbered address may water on even-numbered calendar days only.
3. Residents occupying an odd-numbered address may water on odd-numbered calendar days only.
4. Watering is allowed only between the hours of 5:00 am and 9:00 am, and between the hours of 7:00 pm and 11:00 pm.
5. The only exception is if a significant amount of new grass or sod is installed, and in this case a one week period of watering is allowed from the initial date of installation.

A fine may be issued to anyone not following these
