**PROPOSED CLASS II DEVELOPMENT
 PERMIT**

DP2-01-2013 – 176 Townline Rd West (St. Gregory Catholic School)

TAKE NOTICE that an application for a Class II Development Permit has been received. The Development Permit By-law of the Town of Carleton Place outlines that a Class II Development Permit request is subject to notice of said proposal and a period for the submission of comments from the public.

Comments must be received by April 16, 2013.

The subject land is legally described as part of West half of Lot 13, Concession 12, Geographic Township of Beckwith, now in the Town of Carleton Place. The property is designated as Institutional. It is proposed to add three new kindergarten classrooms, 14 additional parking spaces and the existing playground is to be relocated. Additionally the proponent is proposing changes to the existing fire route. The addition will be adding 473.3 square metres onto the existing school.

Any person may request that a Class II Development

Permit application be referred to Council by means of written request to the Director of Planning and Development. Requests may be forwarded by personal service, ordinary mail or facsimile and must include the name and address of the person or organization requesting the referral to Council as well as the reason(s) for the request.
