As of June 1, 2013 there will be significant changes to the Town of Carleton Place Waste Collection Program. Questions? Call 613-257-2253

Garbage Collection

- The Town of Carleton Place will no longer be handing out garbage stickers and will instead allow one un-stickered bag of garbage each week. Additional bags must have a sticker
- Stickers can still be purchased at Town Hall, IDA, McEwen's Gas Station, Information Centre
- Existing stickers will be honored until 2020.
- The only exception for the new policy will be during the week between Christmas and New Year's when 3 un-stickered bags will be allowed
- Large household items (e.g. couch, chair, mattress, etc.) must have four stickers attached for collection
- Appliances must be properly decommissioned and tagged by a certified technician indicating refrigerant has been properly removed.

Recycling (Blue Bin)

Recycling is now mandatory as Carleton Place strives to reduce municipal waste being sent to landfills

Residents shall now place all #1 through #7 plastics in the blue box for collection

A new company, Matrec, will be collecting recyclables in Carleton Place for the next seven years
