## LAWN WATERING RESTRICTIONS

The Public Works and By-law Enforcement Departments are requesting that residents reduce outdoor water consumption until further notice. The lack of precipitation has resulted in a substantial increase on demand for water from our water treatment plant. It is vital that residents strictly adhere to the Lawn Watering By-law ([By-law 19-2002](#)).

The By-law Department will be increasing enforcement on those who are in violation. The fine for violating the by-law is \$55.00.

By-law 19-2002 regulates the consumption and use of water from May 1st to September 30th. The following regulations apply:

- No person using the Town of Carleton Place water supply system shall water from more than one connection
- Residents occupying an even-numbered address may water on even-numbered calendar days only

- Residents occupying an odd-numbered address may water on odd-numbered calendar days only
- Watering is allowed only between the hours of 5:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m., and between the hours of 7:00 p.m. and 11 p.m.

## CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Thomas Cavanagh Construction Limited has been awarded the contract for the 2016 construction program and work is expected to begin during the week of July 4th. Activity will begin in the area of Pattie Drive. Crews will also be starting the process of removing asphalt and beginning underground infrastructure work. Traffic flow will be impacted on the affected streets and detours may be in place.

We ask for your help in ensuring safe and efficient work zones. Please avoid the construction zones if possible. If necessary navigate construction zones with caution and follow the directions provided by the Traffic Control persons and posted construction signage.
