### LAWN WATERING RESTRICTIONS

The Public Works and By-law Enforcement Departments are requesting that residents reduce outdoor water consumption until further notice. The lack of precipitation has resulted in a substantial increase on demand for water from our water treatment plant. It is vital that residents strictly adhere to the Lawn Watering By-law (By-law 19-2002).

The By-law Department will be increasing enforcement on those who are in violation. The fine for violating the by-law is \$55.00.

By-law 19-2002 regulates the consumption and use of water from May 1st to September 30th. The following regulations apply:

- No person using the Town of Carleton Place water supply system shall water from more than one connection.
- Residents occupying an even-numbered address may water on even-numbered calendar days only.
- Residents occupying an odd-numbered address may water on odd-numbered calendar days only.
- Watering is allowed only between the hours of 5:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m., and between the hours of 7:00 p.m. and 11 p.m.

### FREecycle WEEKEND (JUNE 3-5)

Residents are encouraged to participate in Carleton Place Freecycle taking place Friday June 3 through Sunday June 5. Freecycle is a movement intended to reduce the amount of unwanted items that get sent to the landfill.

To participate, place unwanted re-usable household items at the curb in front of your home on June 3 with a sign or stickers indicating FREE for take-away by neighbours and other residents. Freecycle happens rain or shine - use your discretion when deciding whether to put items at the curb.

Examples of 'freecycling' items include: books, CDs and DVDs; furniture, electronics and small appliances; sports equipment and toys; yard and gardening tools and equipment (e.g., lawn mowers, snow blowers, rakes, shovels); kitchen gadgets, dishes, cutlery, pots and pans; construction materials (e.g., nails, paint, wood); and clothing.

**Items not picked up by 9 p.m. Sunday evening are the responsibility of the homeowner/residents and must be returned to their homes. Leftover objects will not be collected by the Town.**

### HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE FACILITY

The Household Hazardous Waste Facility is now open Saturday mornings 8 a.m.-noon.

Each Saturday until Labour Day residents can bring their household hazardous waste products to our drop off facility located at 128 Patterson Crescent. The Hazardous Waste Facility is available to residents of Carleton Place, Mississippi Mills, Beckwith, Smiths Falls, Perth, Drummond North Elmsley only. - Smoke Detectors
- Tires
