BACKYARD COMPOST REBATE PROGRAM

In an effort to reduce the amount of waste at the curb each week the Public Works Department will be providing residents of the Town of Carleton Place a \$40 rebate for the purchase of a backyard composter. Residents may purchase a composter of their choice and then complete and submit the rebate application. Receipts must indicate purchase in 2016. COMPOST FACILITY NOW OPEN

Starting May 7th, residents can use our compost facility on Patterson Crescent on Saturday mornings (8am-noon) to dispose of yard waste. The compost yard only will also be open Wednesday evenings starting May 11th, 3pm to 8pm.

HYDRANT FLUSHING PROGRAM

Public Works will be conducting an intensive hydrant flushing program and fire flow testing throughout the Town until May 16th. During this time, it is possible the water may appear slightly discolored within the general area that flushing is taking place. Should this occur, turn on your cold water tap and allow the water run for 20-30 minutes.
