DPA-02-2016 - Development Permit Amendment to add a requirement for the construction of model homes within a draft plan of subdivision.

The Committee of Council for Public Meetings (Planning and Development Committee) will hold a **public open house** on Tuesday September 6, 2016 at 5:30 to 6:30 p.m. in the auditorium of the Carleton Place Town Hall 175 Bridge Street, followed by a **public meeting** on Tuesday September 6, 2016 at 8:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the Carleton Place Town Hall, 175 Bridge Street.

In consideration are the proposed revisions within Section 3, General Provisions, of the Carleton Place Development Permit By-law 15-2015. The added provisions will outline special requirements for the construction of model homes within an approved draft plan of subdivision.
