PUBLIC NOTICE

AN APPLICATION TO PERMIT THE OPENING OF RETAIL BUSINESSES WITHIN THE TOWN OF CARLETON PLACE ON STATUTORY HOLIDAYS AS PER SECTION 4(1) OF THE RETAIL BUSINESS HOLIDAYS ACT, CHAPTER R. 30 R.S.O. 1990

TAKE NOTICE that The Council of The Corporation of The Town of Carleton Place has received an application from Stalwart Brewing Company requesting that local businesses be permitted to be open on statutory holidays as defined by Section 1(1) of the said Act.

Section 4(1) of the Retail Business Holidays Act allows a municipality by by-law to permit retail business establishments to be open on statutory holidays for the maintenance or development of tourism.

Further, Section 4(6) of the Retail Business Holidays Act requires a municipality to hold a public meeting to receive comments from the applicant and/or the public prior to the consideration of the adoption of the above-noted By-law and;

Further, that a public meeting (as part of the Policy Review Committee Meeting) to consider this matter will be held on **Tuesday, October 11, 2016** after Council in the Council Chambers of the Town Hall, 175 Bridge Street, Carleton Place, Ontario.
