## SANTA CLAUS PARADE – STREET CLOSURES

On Saturday November 30th the Santa Claus Parade will start at 5:00p.m. In order to accommodate the parade, the following street closures will be in place—Bridge Street at Townline Rd to Landsdowne Avenue up to Coleman Street will be closed to vehicular traffic beginning at 4:30 pm until 7:30 pm. The following streets will experience congestion and will be difficult to pass through from 3:00 pm–5:30pm, Bridge Street, Mailey Drive, Ferrill Crescent, Townline Rd, Thomas Street, Dufferin Street, Moffatt Street Flora Street, McKenzie Street, and Bridge Street though to Quarry Road and side streets entering onto Quarry Rd.

Landsdowne Avenue at Coleman Street will

be closed to regular traffic starting at 5:00pm and will not re-open to regular traffic flow until 7:30 pm
