WINTER PARKING RESTRICTIONS

In accordance with the Town of Carleton Place by-law 2011-050 when Environment Canada forecasts a snowfall of more than 7cm or more for Ottawa and the surrounding area the municipality will issue an on street parking ban. No vehicles shall be parked on municipal streets or parking lots within the Town of Carleton Place between 11pm until 7am. By-law Officers actively enforce winter parking by-laws within the Town of Carleton Place. Vehicle owners will be fined \$65.00 and the vehicle could be towed if interfering with snow removal operations when a ban is in effect or at times when signs are posted for secondary snow bank removal.

FALL LEAF COLLECTION

The curb side collection of leaves will end November 8, 2013.

Residents can deliver yard waste to the compost yard each Saturday 8am – Noon until November 16th (weather permitting).
