Spend an afternoon visiting the Carleton Place and Beckwith Heritage Museum to learn more about the rich history of Carleton Place. Erected in 1872 as the original town hall, the building was home to the community offices, an upstairs meeting hall and a lock up. Converted to a school in 1879, it served the community as Victoria Public School until 1969. Wheelchair accessible.
