

Docks and Public Boat Launches

A public boat launch is available at the West end of Lake Avenue.
2016 Fees are as follows (Prices are subject to change in 2017):
Single day: \$8.00
Season pass (resident of Carleton Place):\$45.00
Season pass (non-resident): \$85.00
Season passes can be purchased at the Town Hall, 175 Bridge St.
Town Hall is open 9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.
Monday - Friday.
Single day passes can be purchased at the boat launch.



Public Dock

The Town has docking at Riverside Park, near the Lake Avenue West boat launch. There is also a municipal dock located off the public parking area across from the Town Hall on Bridge Street. There is also a small dock at Centennial Park for recreational canoe/kayak usage.
