Job Summary:

The Town of Carleton Place is seeking a dedicated Childcare Assistant 1 to join our Childcare Services Department. This role supports the RECE Supervisor and assists in maintaining a safe, nurturing, and positive environment for children. Responsibilities include housekeeping, kitchen, and basic laundry duties to ensure a clean and organized space that supports learning and development.

This position is offered to provide coverage for ongoing leaves of absence within the department. As such, the duration of the assignment is uncertain and dependent on operational needs and the return-to-work dates of employees on leave. If one leave concludes, you may be reassigned to provide coverage for another leave, at the Corporation's discretion.

- Support diapering and toileting routines as necessary.
- Collaborate with team members to enhance the childcare environment.

- Diploma or equivalent education in a related field (e.g., Community and Social Services, Early Childhood Assistant).
- Willingness to obtain and maintain CPR-C/AED, standard first aid, and anaphylaxis training.
- Minimum two years of experience working with infants, toddlers, or in a similar childcare setting.

- Strong communication, problem-solving, and time management skills.
- Ability to lift 45 pounds unassisted and perform various physical activities related to childcare.

This is a Temporary full-time position with irregular or split shifts starting as early as 6:15 a.m. and ending as late as 6:00 p.m. Occasional work beyond regular hours may be required. This role involves both indoor and outdoor work, with exposure to varying environmental conditions.
