No refunds within 6 weeks of rental date.

A swim test is required for ALL children under 10 years of age; some exceptions apply. Non swimmers or those individuals who DO NOT pass the swim test must wear a wrist band and be within arm's reach of their guardian (16 years or older).

The Supervision Policy applies to Camps / General Public for any Pool Rentals, and all scheduled recreational swims.

High risk participants must be in a ratio of 1:1. High risk participants are defined as those who have a condition or illness that may put them at risk in an aquatic environment and those who are unable to control their behavior or impulses and require direct supervision.

Children ages 5 years or younger

Ratio 1:2. Children must be within arm's reach of a guardian who is 16 years or older.

Children ages 6 & 7 years

Ratio 1:4 (No lifejackets). Ratio 1:6 (All in lifejackets). Children must be within arm's reach of a guardian who is 16 years or older. During Public Swims, puddle jumpers are a suitable replacement for a lifejacket / PFD when children are within arm's reach of their guardian.

<u>Children ages 8 & 9 years – DO NOT PASS the Swim Test</u>

- Ratio 1:4 (No lifejackets). Ratio 1:8 (All in lifejackets). Children must be within arm's reach of a guardian who is 16 years or older. During Public Swims, puddle jumpers are a suitable replacement for a lifejacket when children are within arm's reach of their guardian.
- Camp groups and Pool Rentals must use lifejackets, not puddle jumpers.

Children ages 8 & 9 years – PASS the Swim Test

• Ratio 1:10 for camps and pool rentals. Camp leaders are actively participating in the water. During a public swim, a parent or guardian (16 years or older) must remain in the facility.

Children age 10 years and older

Ratio 1:15. Camps – Children do a swimming test, and camp leaders participate in the water. If a child DOES
NOT pass the swim test, they wear a wrist band and a lifejacket, and a caregiver 16 years or older is within arm's
reach of that child.

Rental fees are based on doing your own set up and your own clean up. Any cleanup required to be done by staff will be charged at the current hourly rate.

DOING YOUR OWN SET UP -

- 1. Arranging tables and chairs.
- 2. Putting up all decorations (masking tape only).
- 3. Use of whiteboard, upon request, using only appropriate whiteboard markers (no permanent markers). Use brush provided to clean whiteboard, do not use alcohol-based products.

DOING YOUR OWN CLEAN UP -

- 1. Wipe all tables, counters, and chairs.
- 2. Sweep floors.
- 3. Remove all decorations and leftover tape.

- 4. Replace all tables and chairs in their original positions.
- 5. All garbage must be bagged and ready to be taken out.

NOTE: Rental fees are based on doing your own set up and your own clean up. Any clean up required to be done by staff will be charged at the current hourly rate.
