Permit Checklist (Application will be checked against these requirements)

- Fence shall be of a close boarded, chain link or other approved design, and will be at least 1.5m (5ft) in height and is non-climbable. Above ground pools with sides at least 1.2m (4ft) high are exempt from fence requirements as long as access stairs and removable or able to be locked in the upright position.
- No part of the pool may be closer than 1.0m (3.3ft) to a rear or interior side property line and shall not be closer than 3.0m (10ft) to an exterior side yard and shall not be in the front yard.
- All pool pumps and circulation equipment shall be located in accordance with 2.9 of the By-Law 87-2019.
- No person shall permit any part of a swimming pool within an easement.
- All Gates in the fence that surrounds the pool will have self-latching, self-locking and self-closing device installed on the top interior of the fence/door being installed and will be locked when pool is not in use or supervision when a level of more than 600mm of water is in the pool.
- Fences are to be installed on the owner's property and not on a shared lot line or Town property unless a registered agreement is made with the neighbours as per requirements of the Lined Fences Act.
