Background:

On March 19th the Province of Ontario passed the Municipal Emergency Act, 2020 to permit virtual participation in Council, Committee and Local Board meetings. March 25th, Council passed an amendment to the Town's procedural by-law to allow virtual meetings during a declared emergency.
