IMPORTANT Bronze Program Policy notes:

- Bronze Medallion & Bronze Cross require a practical EXAM by an examiner. Examiners are booked in advance, alternate exam dates cannot be accommodated.
- This is not a combined program, candidates register for either Bronze Medallion or Bronze Cross.
- Payment is required at the time of registration.
- We need a minimum of 8 candidates to run this program. Refunds will not be issued when we get our minimum number of candidates. Full refunds will be issued if the program is cancelled due to insufficient registration.

Covid Protocols:

- Candidates will be divided into pairs the first day, and will work with that same individual for the duration of the program, this is the 'Bubble Buddy' system that is recommended by the Lifesaving Society
- Masks are required, except when in the pool.
- A 'Social Circle' person or family member might be required to assist the candidate in the pool with a portion of the program. The "Social Circle" member is a person who does NOT have to be socially distanced from the candidate. This person will be required to do a swim test, which is 75 m continuous swim (3 lengths of the pool) comfortably.
