## **MUNICIPAL UPDATES**

**Compost Yard Open** - The Public Works Department would like to remind residents that the Compost Yard, located at 128 Patterson Crescent, is now open for residents to dispose of leaf and yard waste. The facility is open Wednesdays from 3:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m., and Saturdays from 8:00 a.m. – 12 noon. Public Works is no longer collecting leaf bags from the curb. Residents are asked to remove any bags remaining at the curb and deliver them to the yard during operating hours.

**Household Hazardous Waste Facility Reopening** - The Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) facility at 128 Patterson Crescent will reopen on Saturday, July 25<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 a.m. to 12 noon. Residents will be required to wear a mask while onsite. If you are displaying any symptoms of COVID-19, we request that you refrain from using the HHW and Compost facilities. Please follow the signage posted.

## **PROVINCIAL UPDATES**

**[Ontario Extends Emergency Orders](#)** - The Ontario government, in consultation with the Chief Medical Officer of Health, has extended most emergency orders currently in force under s.7.0.2 (4) of the *Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act* (EMCPA) until July 29th, 2020. Keeping the emergency orders in place provides the government with the necessary flexibility to ensure the protection of vulnerable populations, such as seniors, while continuing to implement its [Framework for Reopening the Province](#) with many regions entering Stage 3 on Friday.

**[Ontario Extends Expiry Period of Marriage Licences](#)** - The Ontario government is taking steps to extend the expiry period of most marriage licences that have not been used due to the COVID-19 outbreak.
