MUNICIPAL UPDATES

Household Hazardous Waste Facility – The Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) facility at 128 Patterson Crescent will open tomorrow morning for the season. The facility will be open each Saturday until mid-September from 8:00 a.m. – 12 noon. We are asking everyone to be especially patient with HHW staff as we are anticipating a large volume of vehicles during the initial weeks that the facility will be open. Prior to attending the site, we would like residents to be aware of the following requirements due to COVID-19:

- Residents are asked to have their waste items in cardboard boxes or containers that they do not need returned as bins and containers will not be returned once collected by staff. This includes waste oil containers;
- Residents are asked to have their waste ready in the rear of their vehicle, clearly identified, so that staff can easily collect the items while maintaining required physical distancing from residents;
- Residents are asked to wear a mask as they approach the depot and especially while communicating with staff through their window;
- Proof of residency is required! The Household Hazardous Waste facility is limited to residents of Carleton Place, Mississippi Mills, Beckwith, Drummond/North Elmsley, Montague, Smiths Falls, and Perth only.
