[Historic Agreement Delivers Over \\$230 Million for Child Care](#) - The Ontario government, in partnership with the federal government, is providing \$234.6 million in funding to keep children and staff safe in child care and early years settings. This funding will help support enhanced cleaning costs as well as health and safety requirements set out to support the reopening of licensed child care and early years programs. This funding is in addition to the Ontario government’s continued commitment to stabilize the child care sector as many Ontarians return to work.
