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## **MUNICIPAL UPDATES**

**Employment Opportunity** – The Town of Carleton Place is seeking an individual to fill the position of Planning and Building Administration Clerk (Occasional Contract). **Carleton Place Receives Funding Under Federal-Provincial Safe Restart Agreement** - On July 27th, 2020, as part of the federal-provincial Safe Restart Agreement, the Ontario government announced that it had secured up to \$4 billion in emergency assistance to provide Ontario’s 444 municipalities with the support they need to respond to COVID- 19. This investment will provide support to municipalities and public transit operators to help them address financial pressures related to COVID-19, maintain critical services and protect vulnerable people as the province safely and gradually opens. As part of the Agreement, Carleton Place will receive a payment of \$284,900 in immediate funding to support COVID-19 operating costs and pressures.

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**[Canada Revenue Agency opens applications for enhanced Canada Emergency Wage Subsidy](#)** - To ensure that Canadian workers and businesses are in a better position as our economy safely re-opens, the Government has recently implemented changes to the Canada Emergency Wage Subsidy (CEWS) that broaden the reach of the program and provide more targeted support. Today, the Minister of National Revenue, the Honourable Diane LeBouthillier, announced that the Canada Revenue Agency has opened applications for Period 5 – the first period of the enhanced CEWS program.
