The Library is now accepting material returns. With over 4,000 items currently checked out, the library is implementing a staggered return procedure based on patron last name to help mitigate an overflow of materials. All items currently checked out have had their due dates extended to July 1st.

Patrons with last names beginning with letters "H" through "P" - May 26th – 31st

Patrons with last names beginning with "Q" – "Z" - June 1st – 4th

All returned library materials will be quarantined for 72 hours before returning to the Library's collection.
