### **Carleton Place Welcomes a New Recycling Contractor**

The Town of Carleton Place Public Works Department would like to inform residents that effective June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020 Emterra Environmental will be providing recycling collection and processing services on behalf of the Town. **Initially, residents will not see any changes at the curb, however, the Town will begin the transition to a dual stream process with alternating collection of paper products and other recyclable materials each week starting August of 2020.** Residents will be receiving a new yellow bin from Emterra along with promotional information including a calendar to help with the transition. Residents can still use their blue bins for recycling each week. Residents are also encouraged to download the free Carleton Place Waste Solutions App for all your waste collection information.
