Beaches Re-opening June 27th - The Recreation & Culture Department is pleased to announce that Riverside Park & Centennial Beaches will re-open June 27th with lifeguards on duty from 9:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., daily. Please ensure that you maintain physical distancing guidelines of six (6) feet and wash or sanitize hands regularly. Thank you for your cooperation!

Yard Sales – Yard sales are permitted in the Town of Carleton Place, however we have consulted with the local Health Unit in order to share information on how to host a yard sale in the safest way possible. The biggest consideration is that under [Provincial Order](#) you cannot have more than ten (10) people in your yard (including those holding the sale) and customers must remain six (6) feet apart. Customers should handle items as little as possible unless they intend to purchase the item. If an item is handled but not purchased, every effort should be made to clean the item before it is handled by someone else.
