

FEDERAL GOVERNMENT UPDATES

Prime Minister Trudeau announced [important measures within agriculture programs](#) and an investment of more than \$252 million to support farmers, food businesses, and food processors who provide essential services to Canadians every day by ensuring a safe and reliable food supply.

PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT UPDATES

The Ontario government is [extending emergency electricity rate relief](#) to families, farms and small businesses until May 31, 2020 during the COVID-19 outbreak. Customers who pay time-of-use electricity rates will continue to be billed at the lowest price, known as the off-peak price, 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

The Emergency Order closing licensed childcare centres and all facilities providing indoor recreational programs, including EarlyON Child and Family Centres, has been extended until **May 19, 2020**.

The Emergency Order to immediately prohibit organized public events and social gatherings of more than five people has also been extended to **May 19, 2020**.

The Ontario government is [allowing all retail stores with a street entrance to provide curbside pickup and delivery](#), as well as in-store payment and purchases at garden centres, nurseries, hardware stores and safety supply stores.
