[Ontario Investing in Wearable Contact Tracing Technology to Help Protect Workers from COVID-19](#) - Innovative Made-In-Ontario technology will help stop the spread of COVID-19 while creating skilled jobs - The Ontario government is providing [Facedrive Inc.](#) with \$2.5 million through the Ontario Together Fund to accelerate the deployment of its wearable contact tracing technology, TraceSCAN, which alerts users within a workplace who have been in close contact with individuals who have tested positive for COVID-19. The company anticipates manufacturing about 150,000 devices under this project and creating 68 new jobs, including software, firmware and hardware engineers and machine learning specialists.
