SUMMER BREAK NOTICE

Please be advised that in accordance with the Town's Procedural By-law, Council will be taking a summer recess from regular Council or Committee meetings during the month of July. This does not include Special or Emergency Meetings, which can be called by the Mayor or a petition of Council. The next regular meetings after summer recess will take place on August 11th.

PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT NOW OPEN

The Carleton Place Recreation and Culture Department is excited to announce that municipal playground equipment is now open for public use! We would like to remind you to play & stay safe with the following playground guidelines:

- Stay home if you are ill or have symptoms of COVID-19;
- Wash hands with soap and water or use hand sanitizer before and after playing on the playground;
- Ensure you are maintaining a physical distance of six feet/two meters with anyone outside of your household or social circle;
- Refrain from sharing toys with children outside of your household or social circle.

FIRE DEPARTMENT ALLOWS CAMPFIRES

Ocean Wave Fire Company has made the decision to lift the fire ban to allow small campfires. Please remember to follow the Open-air Burn By-law. Small campfires must be in a contained device with a water source close by to extinguish the fire. Please monitor wind and weather conditions to be respectful of your neighbors.

The facility is open Wednesdays from 3:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m., and Saturdays from 8:00 a.m. – 12 noon. Public Works is no longer collecting leaf bags from the curb. Residents are asked to remove any bags remaining at the curb and deliver them to the yard during operating hours.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE FACILITY REOPENING

The Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) facility at 128 Patterson Crescent will reopen on Saturday, July 25th from 8:00 a.m. to 12 noon. Residents will be required to wear a mask while onsite.
