Household Hazardous Waste Facility & Compost Yard Remain Closed

The household hazardous waste and compost site will remain closed until further notice.

Curbside collection of leaf and yard waste will continue and residents are encouraged to place their paper bags at the curb for collection.

Burn Ban Lifted

The Ocean Wave Fire Company has lifted the open air burn ban for the Town of Carleton Place. Open air burning is regulated under the Town of Carleton Place Open Air Burning By-law. The ban was put in place to prevent the rapid spread of fire due to the dry grass and brush exposed after the snow melt and to reduce the firefighter exposures to Covid-19. The recent rainfall and warmer days have made conditions safer for outdoor fires in permitted areas.
