Public Works would like to encourage residents to deliver leaf and yard waste to the Compost Yard at 128 Patterson Crescent. The facility is open each Saturday from 8:00 a.m. to Noon until mid-November, weather permitting.

The curbside collection of leaves **begins** on Monday, November 2nd. The collection period is limited and will end November 13th. Leaves placed at the curb prior to November 2nd will **NOT** be collected. Residents should also be aware the Household Hazardous Waste Depot is now closed and will reopen in May 2021.
