Council and Committee of the Whole Meetings

Virtual Council and Committee of the Whole Meetings - The Town of Carleton Place Council will hold its Council and Committee of the Whole meeting via Zoom on February 23rd, 2021. Amendment to Procedural Bylaw - Take notice that [on February 23rd, 2021](#), the Council of the Town of Carleton Place, will consider amendments to its Procedural By-law [117-2018](#) as follows:

1. amend Section 5.6 to abolish the Striking Committee and to transfer its responsibilities to the Committee of the Whole comprised of all members of Council; and
2. amend Section 9.1.2 to permit Part Lot Control By-laws to be dispensed with in a single motion.

Additional Bag of Waste Extension ENDING

Council made the decision to extend the allowance of two (2) unstickered bags of waste per week, per household to **one week beyond the end of the Provincial shutdown period**. Provided the Stay-at-home Order is lifted in our region on February 16th, the final day of the extension period will be Friday, February 26th. Any additional bags will require a sticker. Residents can continue to use previously issued green stickers.
