NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE FOR STORAGE/SHIPPING/ SEA CONTAINERS

TAKE NOTICE THAT storage/shipping/sea containers meet the definition of a building pursuant to Subsection 1.(1) of the Building Code Act, and as per Subsection 8.(1) of the Building Code Act these structures require a building permit; and

TAKE NOTICE THAT Development Permit By-law 15-2015 recognizes storage/shipping/sea containers as accessory structures which need to meet all of the provisions of Sections 3.2, 13 and 14 of the by-law. An amendment to the Development Permit By-law is currently being considered which will more specifically address these types of structures; and

TAKE NOTICE THAT storage/shipping/sea containers may require a Development Permit to recognize their use on the property prior to a building permit being issued; and

TAKE NOTICE THAT properties must be brought into compliance by December 31, 2019 or by the date that the By-law Amendment is completed, whichever comes first. Any non-complying containers existing after December 31, 2019 or after the date that the By-law Amendment takes effect, shall be subject to any new provisions of

the updated Development Permit By-law. Under the new provisions, storage/shipping/sea containers will not be permitted in certain Development Permit designations.

THE SUBJECT LANDS are described as all the lands within the boundaries of the Corporation of the Town of Carleton Place.
