Responsible person must be in proper bathing attire, in the water, actively participating within arm's reach at all times.

High Risk participants must be in a ratio of 1:1. High-risk participants are defined as those who have a condition or illness that may put them at risk in an aquatic environment and those who are unable to control behaviour or impulses and require direct supervision.
